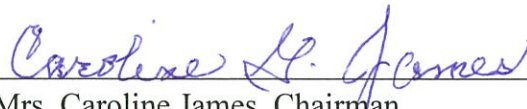


Calhoun County Library
FOOD AND DRINK POLICY
October 21, 2025

Food and drinks are allowed in the library with the following restrictions:

1. No food or open drinks in and around any computer in the library. If a patron wants to eat or drink, they will need to step away from the computer. A patron can have food or drink in sealed containers and be at the computers, but those items cannot be consumed while at the computer stations.
2. No food or drink is allowed in the youth services “stay and play” area.
3. If a patron or group of patrons want to have a gathering with the intention of eating, they will need to book a room through a staff member. Study room, open seating areas, or any room used without booking (South Carolina Room, Ann K. Thornton Board Room, etc.)—these are not available for food centered events. The only rooms that can be booked for food events are the Purple Martin Room, the Magnolia Room, and the Bee Room.
4. No alcohol is allowed in the library at any time during normal business hours.
5. Patrons may not cook or prepare foods in the library.
6. Patrons are asked to report any spills to staff as soon as possible.
