

Calhoun County Library HOMEBOUND SERVICE POLICY

January 21, 2025

The Calhoun County Library provides homebound service to Calhoun County residents who are unable to gain access to materials contained in the library's physical collections. To qualify for the homebound delivery, you must live in Calhoun County and meet one of the following criteria:

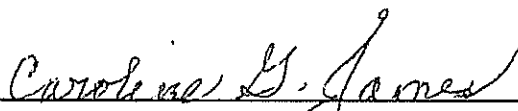
- Condition that restricts your ability to leave your place of residence that lasts over six weeks or is permanent. You may be required to provide medical documentation.
- Can not provide your own transportation because of a disability.

In most circumstances, if a resident drives, he/she would not be considered Homebound.

By using this service, the patron agrees to the library keeping a history of materials checked out in order to aid in the selection of materials delivered.

- The Calhoun County Library has the right to terminate delivery service to any individual who does not meet the criteria as defined above, or if the library staff deems the home environment unsafe or inappropriate.
